2010-2011 Naturalist Internship

Responsibilities: Create a safe learning environment for students to have a positive outdoor experience. Plan and teach hands-on Environmental Science curriculum aligned with the California State Science Content Standards for 5th and 6th grade. Lead activities in various habitats, including bay-oak woodlands, pond, creek, tidepools and ranch garden. Model and encourage environmentally responsible behavior.

Interns will receive four weeks paid training and continuing mentorship throughout the school year. Interns will be responsible for leading hikes, teambuilding and lessons for groups of up to twenty-two students from a variety of cultural, socioeconomic and educational backgrounds. Responsibilities also include working two evening programs a week. Applicants should be physically able to work long hours and participate in strenuous activity. Position requires flexibility and the ability to work as part of a team.

Applicants from diverse backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply.

Qualifications: Experience working with children and completion of college level course work in the Natural Sciences, Environmental Education, Natural Resources Interpretation, Agricultural Sciences or Outdoor Recreation.

Compensation: Room and board plus average of \$64.00/day
